In the Lone Star State, Kenny Marchant Stands Alone

WASHINGTON –Kenny Marchant, candidate for Texas' 24th Congressional District, signed the Americans for Tax Reform (ATR) Taxpayer Protection Pledge, committing him to “oppose any and all efforts to increase the marginal income tax rates for individuals and/or businesses...and oppose any net reduction or elimination of deductions and credits, unless matched dollar for dollar by further reducing taxes.” ATR has offered the Pledge to all federal candidates since 1987.

Current Texas Pledge signers include Representatives Ron Paul, Lamar Smith, Tom DeLay, and Pete Sessions, and Senators Kay Bailey Hutchison and John Cornyn, just to name a few. Bush, 42 U.S. Senators and 217 members of the U.S. House of Representatives have taken the Pledge. Additionally, eight governors and over 1,190 state Senators and Representatives have made this commitment to their taxpayers.

“Texans should be proud of Kenny Marchant,” said taxpayer advocate and president of Americans for Tax Reform (ATR), Grover Norquist. **“He is standing up for families, businesses, and all hard-working people of the state by committing herself to a fiscally responsible term in Congress.”**

Kenny Marchant is a nine term state representative and former mayor of Carrollton City. He faces off in the March 9th primary against former pro-football player Bill Dunn, frequent candidate Cynthia Newman, and Irving City councilman Terry Waldrum. A 24th District native and active member of his community, he is running for this same seat as a commitment to his community and state.

“Signing the Pledge shows Mr. Marchant’s willingness to show his dedication to taxpayers in Texas and across the country,” continued Norquist. **“I encourage all federal and state candidates to commit to leading responsibly, showing their allegiance to their states and country.”**
