## North Dakota: Taxpayer Friendly Candidates for November

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform applauds the following taxpayer-friendly candidates for the general elections for signing the Taxpayer Protection Pledge. By signing the pledge, a candidate commits “to oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

ATR asks all candidates for federal and state office to stand in solidarity with the taxpayers of their entire state, and district if applicable. President Bush has signed the Pledge, and in so doing he joined 42 U.S. Senators, 217 Members of the U.S. House of Representatives, nine Governors, four Lieutenant Governors, two Attorneys General, four Secretaries of State, four Treasurers, and more than 1280 state legislators.

In North Dakota, the following candidates have either won their primaries or are running unopposed:
