Phillip B. Journey Signs ATR Pledge

**-- Newly elected State Senator of Kansas Promises to Oppose Tax
Increases --**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform applauds the pro-taxpayer platform of Phillip B. Journey, who was elected into office December 2nd 2003. He is taking over the seat vacated by Nancy Harrington in the 26th Senate district.

“Senator Journey demonstrated his dedication to the taxpayers of Kansas by signing the Taxpayer Protection Pledge on November 24, 2003. By signing the pledge, Journey promises “to oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

As of today’s date, over 1200 state legislators have signed the Pledge. Nine governors, four Lieutenant Governors, two Attorneys General, four Secretaries of State, four Treasurers, 217 U.S. Representatives, 42 U.S. Senators, and President George W. Bush have signed similar versions of the Taxpayer Protection Pledge.

“Senator Journey joins numerous lawmakers and candidates at the state and federal levels who have committed themselves to principles of limited government,” commented Grover Norquist, President of ATR. . “He understands that the people have to live within their budgets, and that government should do the same.”

“I applaud Senator Journey for his commitment to the taxpayers of the 26th Senate district and all of the taxpayers of Kansas. I extend the invitation to sign the pledge to every candidate running for office, in the hopes that more elected officials will dedicate themselves to taxpayers, rather than tax-and-spending.”
