## **Brian K. Blundell Signs ATR Pledge**

**-- Representative Brian K. Blundell of Hawaii Promises to Oppose Tax  
Increases --**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform applauds the pro-taxpayer platform of Representative Brian K. Blundell. He represents the voters of the 10<sup>th</sup> House district in Hawaii.

Representative Blundell demonstrated his dedication to the taxpayers of Hawaii by signing the Taxpayer Protection Pledge on January 22, 2004. By signing the pledge, Blundell promises “to oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

As of today’s date, over 1200 state legislators have signed the Pledge. Nine governors, four lieutenant governors, two attorneys general, four secretaries of state, four treasurers, 217 U.S. representatives, 42 U.S. senators, and President George W. Bush have signed similar versions of the Taxpayer Protection Pledge.

“Brian K. Blundell is one of numerous lawmakers and candidates at the state and federal levels who have committed themselves to principles of limited government,” commented Grover Norquist, President of ATR.

“I applaud Representative Blundell for his commitment to the taxpayers of the 10<sup>th</sup> House district and all of the taxpayers of Hawaii. I extend the invitation to sign the pledge to every incumbent and candidate running for office, in the hopes that more elected officials will dedicate themselves to taxpayers, rather than tax-and-spending.”
