ATR Congratulates Ohio Primary Winners

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform congratulates the following ATR Taxpayer Protection Pledge signers, who have either won their primary elections on March 2, 2004 or are running unopposed. By signing the pledge, a candidate/incumbent promises “to oppose [and vote against/veto] any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

These candidates have joined President Bush, nine governors, four lieutenant governors, two attorneys general, four secretaries of state, four treasurers and over 1225 incumbent state legislators, all of whom have pledged to oppose tax increases. ATR offers the Taxpayer Protection Pledge to all candidates seeking office at the state and federal levels, and also to sitting incumbents.
