## Americans for Tax Reform Applauds U.S. Senate Candidate Richard Ziser (Nev.)

WASHINGTON— Mr. Ziser demonstrated his dedication to the taxpayers of Nevada by signing the Taxpayer Protection Pledge on January 5, 2004. By signing the pledge, Ziser promises “to oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

As of today’s date, 216 U.S. representatives, 42 U.S. Senators, and President George W. Bush have signed similar versions of the Taxpayer Protection Pledge.
