Diana Newton Signs No-New-Taxes Pledge

-- Candidate for Louisville (KY) Metro Council Promises to Oppose Tax Increases --

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform applauds the pro-taxpayer platform of Louisville (KY) Metro Council candidate Diana Newton. She is running for the 14th district seat.

Diana Newton demonstrated her dedication to the taxpayers of Kentucky by signing the Taxpayer Protection Pledge on January 8, 2004. By signing the pledge, Newton promises “to oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

As of today’s date, over 1260 state legislators, nine governors, four lieutenant governors, two attorneys general, four secretaries of state, four treasurers, 216 U.S. representatives, 42 U.S. senators, and President George W. Bush have signed the Taxpayer Protection Pledge.

“Diana Newton joins numerous lawmakers and candidates at the state and federal levels who have committed themselves to principles of limited government,” commented Grover Norquist, President of ATR.

“I applaud Ms. Newton for her commitment to the taxpayers of the 14th Metro Council district and all of the taxpayers of Kentucky. I extend the invitation to sign the pledge to every incumbent and candidate running for office, in the hopes that more elected officials will dedicate themselves to taxpayers, rather than tax-and-spending.”
