BACKGROUND:

While Virginians have to tighten their belts to pay for the \$1.6 billion tax increase, the Warner administration is sitting on money: The fiscal year 2004 ended with a surplus of \$323.8 million!! Even without a tax increase, the Virginia budget was estimated to increase by 11.6% over the biennium.

34 Republican legislators broke ranks with the Republican party of Virginia and the Republican party as a whole, which stands for lower taxes. They betrayed their constituents by voting for the tax increase, and are now “Virginia’s Least Wanted”.

During the press conference, ATR will unveil a poster displaying the tax hikers, which will be sent to Republicans across the nation to raise their awareness on the importance of a unified ‘no-new-tax’-stance, which has become the branding of the Republican party.
