Today, the U.S. House of Representatives will be considering H.R. 5719. House Republicans will be offering instead the “Tax Increase Prevention Act (TIPRA),” authored by Congressman Tim Walberg (R-MI). Americans for Tax Reform WILL RATE a vote to defeat the “previous question.”

TIPRA would prevent a \$2 trillion tax increase on the American people, or over \$6500 for every man, woman, and child. Congressional Democrats and every Democrat Presidential candidate have endorsed this largest tax increase in American history.

The top tax rate on small businesses would rise all the way to 42.5%. The capital gains rate would increase from 15% to 20%. The dividends tax would spike from 15% all the way to 39.6%. The death tax would leap from the grave in 2010 all the way to a 55% rate in 2011. The child tax credit would be cut in half, and the marriage penalty would once again rear its ugly head for working families.

The U.S. House of Representatives has a chance to prevent this economy-crippling, family-destroying tax hike—today. Congressmen will have to tell the American people on Tax Day just whose side they are on.
